CORPORATE GOVERNANCE TRAINING SPONSORED BY LOCAL EXPERTS

BLOOMFIELD HILLS, Mich. – Creating a financial structure that can meet the regulatory tests of corporate financial reporting is the topic of a new training program sponsored by Bloomfield Hills-based Cendrowski Corporate Advisors (CCA).

The two-day workshop will be offered nationally by the National Association of Certified Valuation Analysts' (NACVA) Consultants' Training Institute (CTI). Designed to train professionals who work for or advise corporations and oversee their financial reporting, it is co-authored by CCA president and founder Harry Cendrowski and senior manager Jim Martin. The workshop will be offered at the Palmer House in Chicago on October 19-20, 2004. Future dates and locations will be announced.

The workshop is based on objectives of corporate governance and covers steps that companies can use to implement and evaluate an appropriate financial reporting structure. It also covers issues facing public companies under the Sarbanes-Oxley Act, according to Cendrowski and Martin.

Topics of study include corporate oversight and board-level requirements, risk-assessment concepts, disclosure controls and procedures, internal-control requirements, and certification of financial statements by management. Case studies are included on maintaining and reporting internal controls and necessary interface with other control professionals. Additional focus is placed on requirements for controls, evaluation, testing and validation.

The CFD program is the first new fraud-deterrence designation by an established national professional organization in 20 years.
